Samaritan's Purse Education Resources Activity

BioSand Filter: Artwork

NOTE: This activity should be done in conjunction with the Bible lesson [Taking Care of God's Gifts](#).

Age Group Children in grades K – 2

Materials Materials are selected by the leader, according to the media in which the children will complete their artwork:

White paper

Crayons

Pencil crayons

Felt pens

Water color paints

Activity A teacher or parent has the children draw or paint in the BioSand Filter on the coloring page. Inside the interior lower box, they should be instructed to draw in the rocks and sand that are key parts in filtering water – stones that can fit into the palm of your hand in the bottom five centimeters around the pipe, then pebbles in the next five centimeters above, and fine sand all the way up to the diffuser plate. Suggest that the stones and pebbles can be colored any hue and the sand be brown.

Reflection After activity time is over, gather the children in a circle and encourage them to take home their artwork and explain to their parents what they learned about caring for God's creation and caring for others by helping them get safe water to drink.
