- **Donor Ministries** be part of a team dedicated to building and nurturing relationships with our donors to ensure the continued growth and success of our mission. As an intern, you may contribute in several impactful ways including database management, research, and stewardship materials.
- **Operation Christmas Child** contribute to a meaningful cause that brings joy and hope to children in need around the world. Interns may gain experience in event coordination, awareness campaigns, and logistical support.
